Location:

Studio Itaka, Korunní 35, Praha 2.

The studio is located near the center, close to the metro station Náměstí Míru (green line - A), 1 stop from there by tram 10, 16 (to Šumavská stop). The pink building is right in front of the stop. Ring the bell Itaka- recepce.

From the railway station: take the metro line C (the red one) – it is the station Hlavní nádraží and go to the station I.P.Pavlova. Get off and take tram 10,16 on the side where KFC is, get off at the second stop (Šumavská).

Accommodation in Prague:

You can stay at the studio overnight, for 5 EUR/night. You need a sleeping bag. There are thin mats available but if you have your own it is better if you bring it. The studio have showers.


Language:
